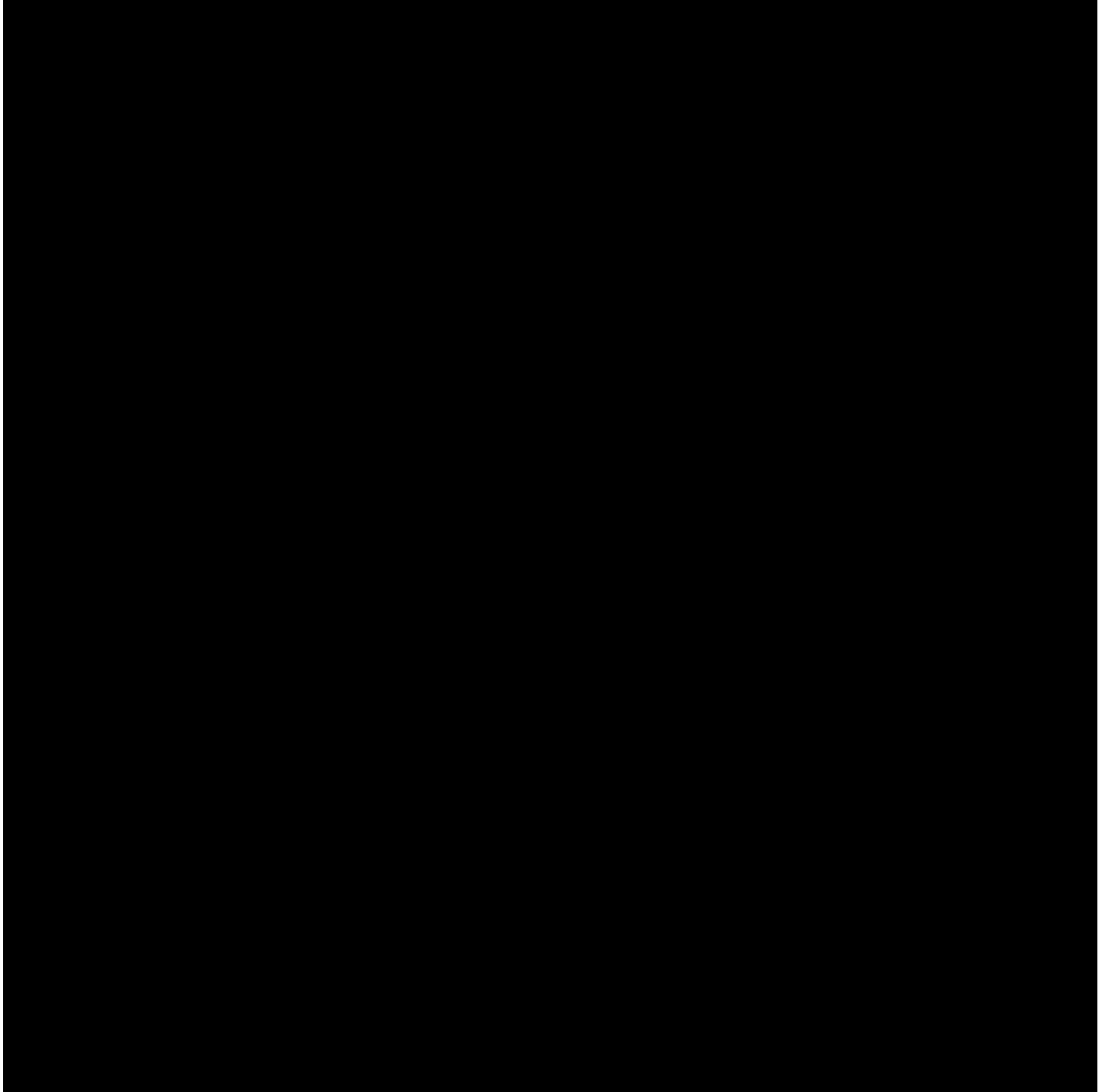
Thus, I developed Empathy Project to encourage everyone to work collaboratively
